Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Scholarship

All materials must be received by February 1st

The University of Missouri is proud to partner with Project Lead the Way (PLTW) to offer scholarships to high school students graduating from a certified PLTW high school. Students who qualify will receive a \$500 one-time scholarship.

Criteria for receiving award:

- Applicant must be graduating from a certified Project Lead the Way (PLTW) high school and complete a minimum of two Project Lead the Way courses. Final course grades must be a B or higher.
 - Applicant must be accepted for admission to the University of Missouri and complete an online Student Financial Aid application. <http://financialaid.missouri.edu/applying-for-aid/index.php>
- Applicants must apply for campus scholarships by December 15th to be considered for a FIRST Scholarship. Please visit your <https://myzou.missouri.edu> to apply.
- Applicant must have outstanding academic credentials with a minimum Composite and Math ACT scores of 28.
 - Applicant must have a PLTW Teacher and High School Counselor complete the PLTW Teacher/ Counselor Form. A current transcript must accompany the form.
 - Students taking their second PLTW course in their senior year must submit the PLTW application and their current transcript no later than February 1st. To complete the application, a final transcript must be received no later than June 30th. For these students, notification concerning the award will be made via email after the revised June 30th deadline. All other students must meet the February 1st deadline.

All scholarship materials must be received by **February 1st**.
